To: All Members and Relatives

In order to reward academically outstanding members' children and to assist those from families in need, the association will accept applications for scholarships from members for their children for the academic year 2024 - 2025. The application period is from now until March 15, 2025, for scholarships for universities, polytechnics, junior colleges, and technical education institutions, as well as for primary and secondary schools.

Scholarship Awards 2025

- 1. Children of members enrolled in universities or polytechnics in the 2023/2024 academic year with outstanding academic performance.
- 2. Children of members enrolled in polytechnics in the 2024/2025 academic year with outstanding academic performance.
- 3. Children of members enrolled in primary schools, secondary schools, junior colleges, or technical education institutions in 2024 with outstanding academic performance.

Bursary Awards 2025

- 1. Bursary Award will be provided to children of members attending primary, secondary, junior colleges, polytechnics, or technical colleges in 2024 who require financial assistance.
- 2. For applicants seeking financial aid, the evaluation committee will focus primarily on family financial status, with academic performance considered for reference.

Distribution of Scholarship and Bursary Awards

- University Group: \$500 each for 2 recipients
- Junior College Group: \$300 each for 2 recipients
- Polytechnic Group: \$300 each for 2 recipients
- Technical Education Group: \$300 each for 2 recipients
- Secondary School Group: \$200 each for 6 recipients
- Primary School Group (Grades 1 to 6): \$100 each for 12 recipients

Members who wish to apply for scholarships / bursary awards for their children should complete the attached application form (please photocopy if more copies are needed) and submit it along with a photocopy of the full-year (both semesters) report card before the deadline. Late submissions will not be considered.

- 1. University Group: Must include academic results from July 2023 to May 2024.
- 2. **Polytechnic Group**: Must include academic results from April 2024 to March 2025.
- 3. **Primary, Secondary, Junior Colleges, and Technical Education Groups**: Must include academic results from the entire 2024 academic year.
- The scholarship evaluation committee will notify applicants of their eligibility after review.
- The association reserves the right to address any deficiencies in these guidelines as deemed necessary.
